Knowledge repository

The knowledge repository collects:

- documents from the EC and other relevant policy bodies, including ESFRI roadmaps and national roadmaps
- information on RIs, researchers, organisations and services linked to RIs
- surveys and information on European, national and regional RI projects and initiatives.

The repository is a central information hub to a whole range of stakeholders dealing with research infrastructures as well as the basis for our observatory activities.

Observatory actions

The observatory actions focus on monitoring national Research Infrastructures policies, programmes and initiatives, in relation to EC policy recommendations. We make analyses of:

- European and national policies, funding and programmes for Research Infrastructures, per research field
- National RI roadmaps and their relations to the ESFRI roadmap.



Four field reviews are undertaken to describe examples at the national / regional level.

The observatory actions refer also to the international cooperation area, aiming at:

- collecting information on policies, initiatives and studies related to the promotion of international RI partnerships
- building a database of RIs located in countries, with which the EU has concluded S&T Cooperation Agreements
- examining drivers for international collaboration in RIs.

The results will be disseminated to EC representatives, national and regional decision making bodies, members of the ESFRI, e-Infrastructure Reflection Group, RI project coordinators and operators, international RI organisations, ERA-NET partners.
